The Old Goods Yard is the design and conversion of the existing Old Goods Yard building at Christ's Hospital, Horsham. The proposal provided 7 duplex flats, (a mixture of 1/2 bedroom apartments), for affordable rent and for the S106 contributions for the wider Christ Hospital new build site.

The project required extensive design work pre-tender which included several feasibility options and spatial sketches provided to the Client for their consideration.
